Red Paddle Co 10'6 2017 - **SOLD**



The Red Paddle Co 10'6 2017- **£480**.

The board comes with a bag, which is very sought after, pump, paddle and leash.

The Red Paddle Co Rides have been the market leader for years now. There were major changes for the 2016 model, which were continued into the 2017 model. The board is missing the deck bungie and one of the bungie attachments, which can both be replaced very easily. Otherwise it's been well used, as you'd expect, but has no repairs or leaks. It has plenty more years in her.

The board comes with a bag, which alone is very sought after. The Titan pump, which is the best hand pump on the market. A paddle and leash.

Since the major changes for the 2016 model, the design and construction hasn't changed. For the 2018/19 model the only changes were cosmetic. This board is also missing the deck bungie and 3 of the bungie attachments, which can both be replaced very easily.

This board again has no repairs or leaks.

RRP was **£869**.



Red Paddle Co Ride 10'8 2018/19

The Red Paddle Co Ride 10'8 2018/19 - **£595**.

The board comes with a bag, which alone is very sought after. The Titan pump, which is the best hand pump on the market. A paddle and leash.

With the 10'8 the design and construction is the same, with the exception of the board being two inches wider and therefore more stable. Ideal for those who are looking for a board with more stability or those who are over 100k.

This board is just missing the deck bungee.

This board again has no repairs or leaks. **RRP was £869**.

GA IQ Free 10'6 2018

The GA IQ Free 10'6 2018 - **£390**.

Comes with just a paddle and leash.

GA is a well known brand, more for windsurfing than SUPs, and the IQ is a well made board which is relatively quick and easy to use. I've not had any issues with them except that they are slightly less stable than the Red 10'6. It comes with a single fin design.

This board doesn't have any repairs or leaks, however the deck pad is in a bad state. It is replaceable if you were to decide to do so.

GA IQ Free 10'7 WS 2018



The GA IQ Free 10'7 WS 2018 - **£440**.

Comes with just a paddle and leash.

The 10'7 is the same as the 10'6, except it comes with an attachment for a windsurf sail and a central fin.

This board doesn't have any repairs or leaks.

RRP was £749

Sandbanks SUP Style 2017



The Sandbanks SUP Style 2017 - £330

Comes with a paddle and leash.

Sandbanks is a local brand so I tried out their board. It's good but definitely not as stable as the other boards I have. Well suited a light paddler.

There is a theme here, as with lots of my boards, the deck bungie attachments have broken. They can be replaced.

Fatstick 10'6 WS 2017 - **SOLD**

The Fatstick 10'6 WS 2017 - £350

Comes with a paddle and leash.

Fatstick is another good local brand. Unlike the Sandbanks, this is a stable board well suited to a larger paddler. It also comes with fittings for a windsurf sail and a central fin.

I failed when compiling this to take a photo of the top of this one. But again it's in good condition considering its use.

Starboard Whopper ws 2016

Comes with just the board.

Starboard is a top brand and this board is a great stable board. It doesn't have lots of volume and so isn't so well suited to a larger paddler. It comes with fittings to attach a windsurf sail and central fin.
