HSC ADVISORY NOTICE

Following the Governments recent relaxation of the covid rules and regulations. Which are now replaced with advisory notes.

The committee is pleased to announce that the clubhouse is now fully open in all areas.

However the HSC covid subcommittee ask that the following advisory points are observed when members are within the clubhouse.

- **Any member who feels ill or displays any of the known covid symptoms. Are to leave the club immediately and go home, for the protection of other members.**
- Members are requested when entering the main hall to please continue to sign in the entry log or use the NHS Q code.
- **We advise that face coverings be worn within the main hall except when seated, drinking or eating.**
- Members to be aware of other people and avoid overcrowding especially within the bar area. **2 persons only at the bar counter at any one time. Please wear face coverings at the bar counter for the protection of the volunteering members that are serving you.**
- Please continue to use the hand sanitisers and cleaners that are located around the club.
- Where possible maintain at least one metre distance from other members, particularly within the changing rooms.
- Members unlocking, ensure that the changing room windows and doors are opened and the escape doors to the main hall are opened, if members are in the main hall. To ensure adequate ventilation of the clubhouse.
- Following use of the tables or galley counter within the main hall can members please wipe over with the spray cleaner provided prior to leaving. Leave as you would expect to find.
